Club Background

The Infant Jesus Soccer Club (IJSC) has been in existence for over 40 years and is proud to represent the Infant Jesus Primary School within the Football West State Mini-Roos Soccer League.

The IJSC is one of the few remaining catholic school soccer clubs within the state and as such provides a rather unique environment for its members. A key tenant of the IJSC constitution is for the values of the Infant Jesus Primary School to be upheld and fostered within its membership.

The IJSC operates as a sub-committee of the Infant Jesus P&F and works within the Sub-Committee Guidelines.

IJSC is run 100% by parent volunteers and we need your help in any way you can. If you would like to volunteer, coach or join the committee please get in contact.

Training & Matches

Training will commence on the 14th of March with the first game scheduled for the 30th of April.

- Training

U5s to U7s – Training is undertaken on Tuesdays at Emberson Reserve Morley between 5-6pm

U8s to U12s – Training days and times will depend on the Team Coach but normally will be undertaken on Tuesdays & Thursdays at Emberson Reserve between 5-6pm.

- Match Days

U5s to U7s are part of a cluster group with several other clubs in the local area. Each club will take turns in hosting the other clubs. Games will be Sundays mornings with times to be confirmed.

U8s to U12s teams will be placed in a division with several other clubs and matches on Sunday mornings undertaken on a Home & Away basis.

Note - Fixtures & Times will be released closer to the season start by Football West.

Registration & Fees

For U8s and above, team spots are limited, and registration is required to secure your child's place in the team.

Season 2023 registration fees are \$210 per player and \$190 per sibling.

Part of the fees goes directly to Footballwest to cover registration and insurance. The rest of fees goes to the club, which is used for playing strips, equipment, line marking, trophies, photos, and events.

Fees are due by the 1st of April 2023. Payment is required for your child to be able to receive their playing jersey and participate in the first game of the season.

The IJSC is proudly a part of the Infant Jesus School Community and applies the values of the school to its operating activities.

Should a parent or guardian be unable to comply with the fee payment policy they should contact IJSC.

The IJSC will endeavour to support families to ensure their children are able to participate in the Football West Mini-Roos competition. All such enquiries will be handled in confidence.

Uniform

As part of the registration fees the club will loan out the playing jersey for the season.

IJSC Shorts & Socks are required for game days and can be purchased from Onside Sports.
